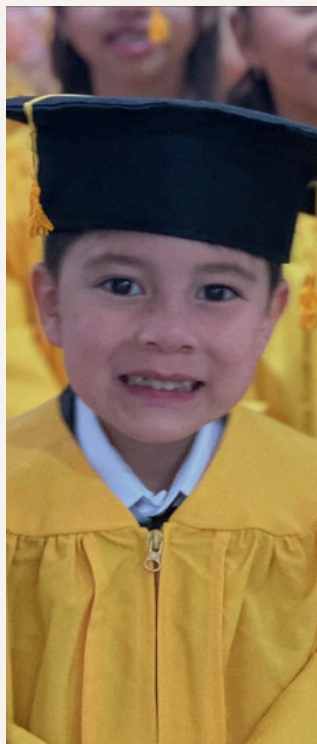

DISCIPLES MAKING DISCIPLES ACROSS BORDERS

Across Europe, Missionary Ventures missionaries continue to walk alongside believers from many cultures and backgrounds, helping them grow as disciples of Jesus. Through ongoing mentoring, leadership development, and relational discipleship, local believers are being equipped to share their faith and invest in others within their own communities. Initial relationships have grown into a network of leaders who are now discipling others and helping strengthen churches across national borders like Ukraine and Russia. These efforts demonstrate the power of multiplication—when faithful disciples are equipped and encouraged, the impact of the gospel extends far beyond any single ministry or country.

EQUIPPING THE NEXT GENERATION OF LEADERS

LATVIA

At the Baltic School of Ministry (BSM) in Latvia, young believers from across Europe are being disciplined and equipped for lives of faithful ministry. Through Bible teaching, spiritual formation, and intentional community, students are growing in their understanding of God's Word while learning how to serve the Church and their communities. Many arrive seeking clarity about their calling and leave with a deeper commitment to follow Christ and invest in others. By cultivating both theological foundation and spiritual maturity, BSM plays an important role in strengthening churches throughout Europe as graduates return home prepared to disciple others and lead with humility and conviction.

CYPRUS

In Cyprus, Missionary Ventures missionaries are helping create spaces where believers can grow deeply in their faith while preparing to serve the Church. Through discipleship training, teaching, and community life connected to the EQUIP International School of Biblical Training, students are developing both a strong biblical foundation and a heart for ministry. Many of those who pass through this training return to their home countries with renewed vision to disciple others and strengthen local churches. By investing in the spiritual formation of emerging leaders, this ministry is helping equip a new generation of believers across Europe to faithfully live out and share the gospel.

CHURCH STRENGTHENING

UGANDA

BROKENNESS TO BREAKTHROUGH

When Rex and Melinda Gynn first set foot in Uganda nearly 20 years ago, they had no idea how deeply God would root them in one of the most remote corners of Africa in a region still healing from decades of war. What began as a short-term mission journey has become a lifelong calling to restore hope, train leaders, and disciple a new generation across northern Uganda. Today, the Gynns oversee a thriving network of five churches, three schools, and more than 20 Kids Clubs that reach over 1,500 children every week. Many of these gatherings still meet under trees, where children and adults alike hear the Word, sing, and share meals through weekly feeding programs.

URUGUAY

BRINGING GOD'S KINGDOM TO SECULAR SHORES

A team from Christian Motorcyclists Association and MV traveled to Uruguay to support MV missionaries Gustavo and Dani Huamani and equip local pastors with transportation. Gustavo and Dani left their native Peru to follow God's call to Uruguay after they asked God to give them something difficult to pursue for Him. In a country that is less than 10% Christian, it has not been easy, but they have great faith. They work closely with pastors in Chuy and Rocha, and the team joined them in prayers for the nation on its independence day as well as delivering transportation (motorcycles) to local pastors thanks to the partnership of MV and CMA.

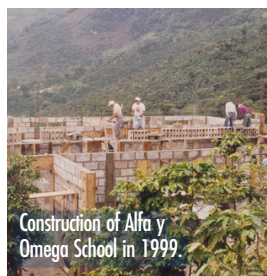
Nearly three decades ago, MV missionaries Arlen and Keturah King, alongside an MV team from Canada, helped build Alfa y Omega School in the mountains of northern Guatemala. The construction project was never just about classrooms—it was about creating a place where discipleship could take root for generations. Today, that legacy continues to grow.

MV missionary Teresa Harwood now serves this same community, carrying forward the foundation laid years ago. While her work strengthens the school academically, her calling is also relational and spiritual—discipling teachers, encouraging local leaders, and walking alongside families as they grow in faith. Through relationship, prayer, mentorship, and service, Teresa helps cultivate a culture where education and discipleship go hand in hand.

The impact reaches beyond students. Teachers are being equipped not only as educators but as spiritual influencers in their classrooms and communities.

The school has become a gathering place where faith is modeled, relationships are strengthened, and the hope of the gospel is lived out in practical ways. Teresa is working specifically to equip teachers with enhanced English lessons and ESL training as a member of the MV School Strengthening team.

At the end of 2025, she hosted her first-ever short-term team, which went to serve Alfa y Omega school and the supporting local church. They continued the vision, investing in people through encouragement, ministry, and shared service projects that support both the school and the surrounding town. Together, local believers and visiting teams demonstrate what long-term partnership looks like—faithfulness that spans decades. The team is even taking that partnership back to North Carolina where they hope to grow the relationship with their own Christian school.

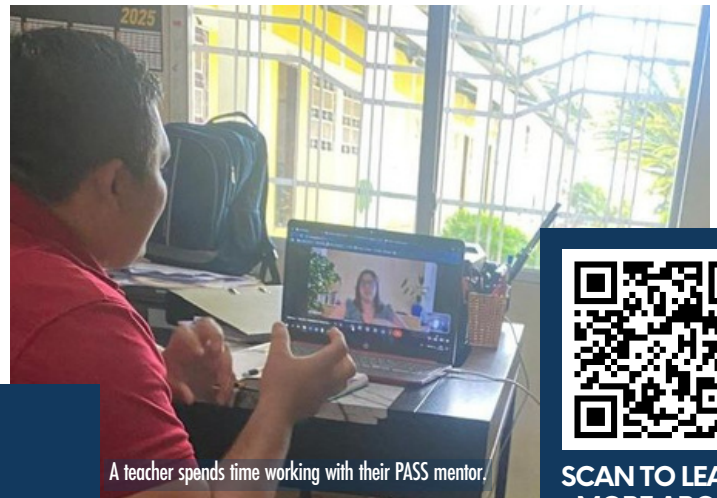

PHILIPPINES

RESPONDING WITH HEART & PURPOSE

In the Philippines, Missionary Ventures partners stepped into communities recovering from a series of devastating earthquakes, bringing both immediate aid and long-term encouragement to pastors and families navigating the aftermath. At the same time, a team from the Christian Motorcyclists Association traveled to Mindanao and Cebu to strengthen local ministries through our transportation program. By delivering motorcycles and boat motors to pastors serving remote villages, the team helped extend the reach of the gospel to communities that are otherwise difficult to access. These efforts reflect the heart of MV's compassion ministry—responding to urgent needs while equipping local leaders to continue serving their communities with the hope of Christ.



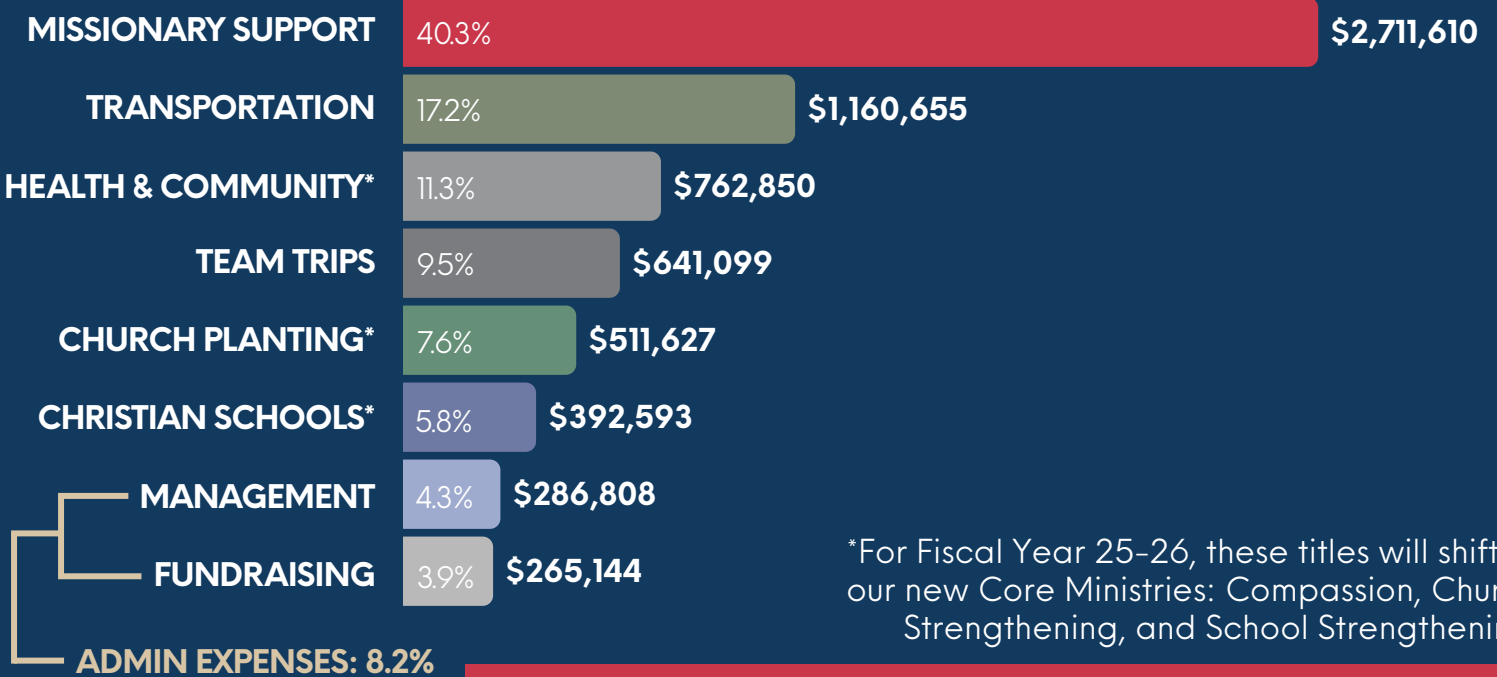

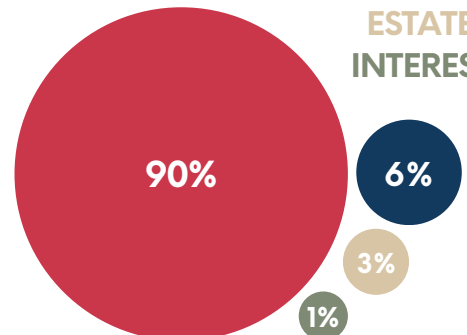
